Competition Explanations

Wayne Burns Old Timer Trophy and Stewart Cobcroft REDeX Trophy

These nominated speed competitions are run over 1 round, and are open to any open-wheel car without tuned pipe and without springing of the driving wheels (i.e. C Grade or M Class only). The car closest to the nominated is the winner.

Speed Competition

This is an outright speed event run over two rounds, open to cars from all classes.

Harry Ferguson Trophy

This two round competition is open to 3.5 cc M Class cars only, with the fastest car of the day declared the winner.

Worfold Trophy Points Score

This competition is run over two rounds on each of the five running days throughout the year. Each member is allowed only one car, and this car must be the same one run on each of the Points Score running days. During each run, the car must complete eight laps under its own power, excluding horsing. Each competitor will receive 4 points for attendance, and 8 points for 8 laps under power (pro rated for less) giving a maximum of 20 points per running day, or 100 points for the year. In the event of a tie for first place at the completion of the last round, these tied drivers will complete in a nominated speed event to decide the winner.

Percy Clarke Trophy

This is a nominated speed event run over two rounds, where any car which exceeds its nominated speed is disqualified and excluded from the results. The car with the closest speed below or on its nominated is the winner.

Australian Championships

This is an outright speed event run over two rounds, open to cars from all classes.

Cyril Clydesdale Toowoomba Trophy

This nominated speed competition is run over two rounds, with any car that is slower than its nominated being disqualified and excluded from the results. Cars must complete both rounds above their nominated, and the car with the closest speed in either run on or above its nominated is the winner.

QMRCC Anniversary Championships

This is an outright speed event run over two rounds, open to cars from all classes.

McPherson Trophy

This is a nominated speed event run over two rounds, with the closest to the nominated speed from either round being declared the winner.

CC Barnes Shield Standing 500 metres Trophy

This competition is open to all classes, and is run over one round. Cars are timed over 500 metres from a standing start, with the fastest time being declared the winner.

Castrol Trophy

This competition is run over two rounds, with the fastest car from any class on the day being declared the winner.

Club Champion Trophy

Points for all competitions throughout the year are totalled, with each driver being awarded points only for the one car they have nominated for the relevant competition. *Different cars can be nominated for different events.* Points will be awarded for each competition as follows:

1st - 25 Points	6th - 8 Points
2nd - 18 Points	7th - 6 Points
3rd - 15 Points	8th - 4 Points
4th - 12 Points	9th - 2 Points
5th - 10 Points	10th - 1 Point

WMCR Sanctioned Event

Note that Australian record claims will only be accepted on events marked as 'WMCR Event'.
